A Survivor's Success Story

For years, Telma was unaware of the services Safe Passage provides and was experiencing abuse in her home. Her abuser isolated her from her friends, family and support systems including services in the community. He led her to believe that she would lose her



daughter if she reported the abuse due to her legal status. Thankfully, Telma had the courage to confide in a school staff member of the abuse that she was going through. Thanks to that staff member, she and her daughter were able to flee to safety in Safe Passage's emergency shelter.

Once at Safe Passage, Telma enrolled in English Second Language classes, gained employment, and purchased a car. Shortly after, she moved into Safe Passage's Long-Term Housing Program and actively participated. She met with a domestic violence counselor and her Long-Term Case Manager where she worked through trauma, goals, and life skills. Telma eventually applied for a U-Visa, received a work permit, and a social security number. Her work permit and social security number has opened new employment opportunities with better working conditions and benefits which will change the quality of both her daughter and her life. One of Telma's dream is to take CDL classes and is currently working on this goal.

Telma continues to stay in touch with us and shares her accomplishments. Her case manager, Maria, says, "I enjoy working with Telma and admire her determination to break away from the cycle of violence and identify abusive behavior. Telma has overcome many of the additional barriers that keep many undocumented survivors in abusive relationships."
