Feeling The Love



This past month, Safe Passage had the privilege of collaborating with local theatre, Stage Coach Players, to conduct V's (formerly known as Eve Ensler) The Vagina Monologues. Through interviews with survivors, V illustrates the feminine experience and how the stigmas of sexual assault play a factor. Sex work, rape, masturbation, birth, orgasm, and female genital mutilation—these topics, though taboo at one point, were all addressed in the monologues. It gave a sense of empowerment and realism to the feminine experience. The audience from both nights were moved through the cast's rawness and witty storytelling.

Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month

February is acknowledged for Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month. Not only does Safe Passage offer services for adults, we also offer services to children and teens who have experienced and/or witnessed abuse. Abuse can happen to anyone— even those at a young age. For this reason, our Prevention Staff has been traveling to schools again around the local county to teach students how to identify both domestic abuse and sexual assault. These presentations go over what consent is and emphasize that students are in control of their bodies. From students as young as kindergarteners all the way to seniors in high school, our prevention staff educates them to not only prevent abuse for themselves but as well as recognizing and

proactively preventing it with their loved ones.

Presentations have been held both virtually as well as in-person in consideration of the pandemic.



Virtual Legal Clinic (VLC)

The legal advocates at Safe Passage have began utilizing the VLC to help clients. The VLC is a program within ICADV that helps domestic violence survivors. It provides members & clients free personalized information and advice about their legal rights from volunteer attorneys. This program will be held through a webcam platform; this will provide clients a convenient and safe way of obtaining their legal resources.

Interns & Volunteers


